STUDENT SUBMISSIONS

POSTER FORUM

A poster forum will be held at the conference for medical students who have been on electives at home or abroad, to discuss their experiences.

Students will create a poster about their elective with regards to the theme 'transforming electives.' The theme is quite broad, for example you may wish to focus on examples of how the elective transformed you personally, any innovative research you may have completed or impact to the host.

As well as creating a poster, students will present in front of the audience, where they will have one minute and 30 seconds to answer the following questions:

1. How has your elective transformed you?

2. How has your elective transformed your work?

3. How did your elective transform your host?

You may wish to create a one page PowerPoint slide to be projected as you are asked these questions, to give a summary of where you went on elective.

After all students have answered, you will have the opportunity to present your poster to delegates. Posters will be displayed around the room where you will be able to explain your elective in more detail and attendees will have the chance to ask you questions.

NARRATIVE

A panel of five medical students will have the chance to provide an oral narrative of their elective focusing on the question:

"Challenges and how I overcame them"

You will have around 6 minutes to present a narrative answering this question. Challenges may include practical and personal issues and what you would think future medical students can learn from your experience. There will be a Q&A from the audience once all students have presented.

HOW TO PRESENT

Applications are open to medical students and graduates. If you wish to present a poster or narrative, you must complete a short abstract (maximum 250 words) answering why your elective was transformative.

The deadline for submissions will be Friday 22nd September 2017.

MSC Electives Committee


The Committee consists of the electives leads from UK medical schools. They are national experts who work to improve the value and safety of electives, as well as discuss guidance and standards.
